Participation: Participation is open to all NTTB members and members of

federations affiliated with the ITTF

Tournament structure 2nd: First singles category: Girls and boys are separated in different

divisions by age and license as much as possible. First round round-robin stage in each group, followed by knockout competition.

Second singles category: Classification by strength in mixed divisions. First round round-robin stage in each group, followed by knockout

competition.

Youth: born in or after 2000. Age groups are indicated on the

registration form and on the website

Tournament structure 3rd: First round round-robin stage with a minimum of five players per

group, followed by knockout competition with a main tournament

and a consolation tournament.

Classification by license. Merging of different license categories if needed. For youth players and foreign players an assessment of level

of play will be made to determine their category.

Tournament structure Top: Preliminaries in groups of four players maximum, with at least the

numbers one and two playing in the knockout competition.

Registration: Registration: Classification is made in accordance with the license

indicated on the August 2017 NTTB list. This list is binding.

Registration is only possible through www.openzeeuwse.nl, for both

clubs and individuals.

prizes.

Awards ceremony: Awards will be distributed on Saturday September 2nd at the end of

the tournament and on Sunday September 3rd after each category.

Balls: There will be played with Non-celluloid, Xushaofa\*\*\* balls

Participants: Each participant is responsible for the correctness of his or her

registration. With registration the participant furthermore agrees to

the possible combining or eliminating of categories.

Apparel/shoes: It is mandatory to wear NTTB approved sportswear and athletic

shoes..

Admission: Admission to the halls and stands is free. The court is only accessible

to players and coaches.

Gluing: Gluing of rubber in the sports venue De Sprong is prohibited.

Restaurant: Refreshments are available in the cafeteria of De Sprong.

Insurance: Legal liability insurance and accident insurance will apply to all NTTB

members. This is not the case for non-members, including foreign

participants.

Provisions: The tournament committee and/or leaders retain all rights as defined

in the NTTB tournament and competition rules.
